

The sofa's frame has been made with plywood and metal tubing and uses Dupont Dacron for the padding. Its coating is made with a special bi-elastic fabric made of wool and lycra, which is 100 per cent washable

## WHAT



**el'bo** by Garima Aggarwal, an NID and CEPT graduate - This is a stackable seat that uses bamboo as the primary material. It can also be used as a base of a stool or a coffee table and has been tested for load bearing. The bend is made of bamboo splits that are heated and bent around a jig and then stuck back to back



**'Dipinta de blu'** by Adele C SRL - A fragile form supported by a tough material like carbonium, the piece is an example of how technology can help explore new forms
